

Updating Geogrid® Viewer from Version 2.0 or above to Version 3.2

Setup will only start if Geogrid Viewer Version 2.0 or above is already installed on your computer. (You can find the number of your version by opening the program and clicking on "Information" in the "Help" menu.)

Please have your original Viewer CD ready and available. You will be asked to insert it into the CD-ROM drive during the installation process.

The update program will initially search for all Geogrid Viewers from Version 2.0 onwards installed on your computer. If it finds a Version 1.x or Version 3.2, Setup will be aborted.

The Viewer products found will be displayed in a dialogue window. If several Viewer products were found, you can choose to update all of them at once or each one separately.

Setup will replace the old program files. The initialisation file (d2vexcrd.ini) will be maintained so that your settings are not lost.

Please note that an up-to-date Dynamic Perspectival View (DPV) application will also be installed along with the update.

Taking over existing DPV settings after the update

The installation directory for the DPV has changed since Geogrid Viewer Versions 2.x. If you would like to keep your present DPV settings, you need to copy the file DynPerspView.ini from the folder C:\Programs\Dornier GmbH\Geogrid DynPerspView to C:\Programs\Geogrid\DPV after carrying out the update.

If you update a Geogrid Viewer of Version 3.x, your settings in the configuration file DynPerspView.ini will be backed up in the file DynPerspView.old1. If a file of that name already exists, the number at the end will be increased by 1. Users of this version who wish to keep their present preferences need to remove the file DynPerspView.ini and change the name of the file DynPerspView.oldx (x = 1, 2,...) to DynPerspView.ini.
